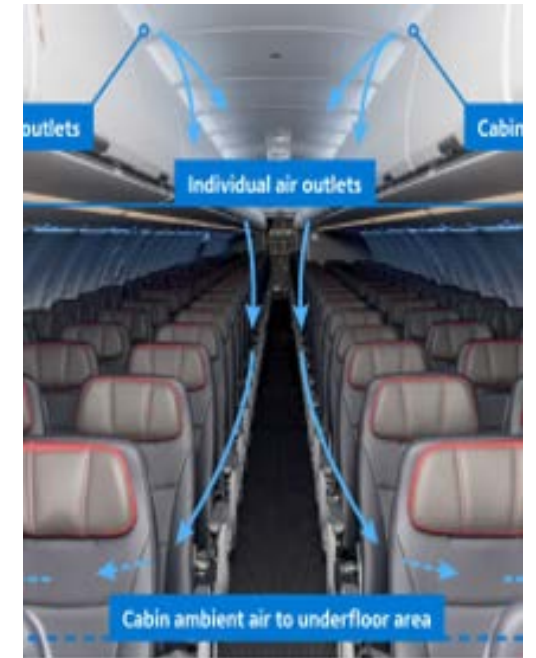

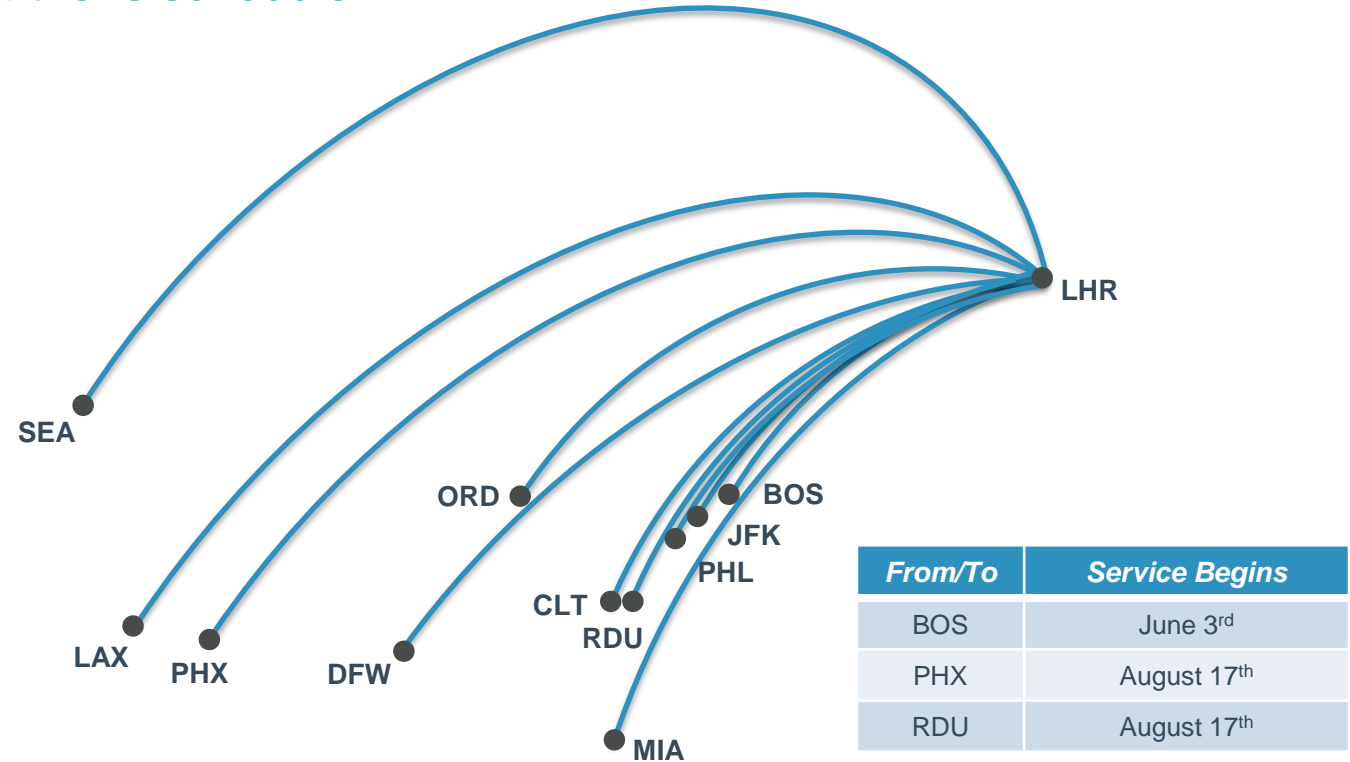

Our service complements our joint business partner's schedule

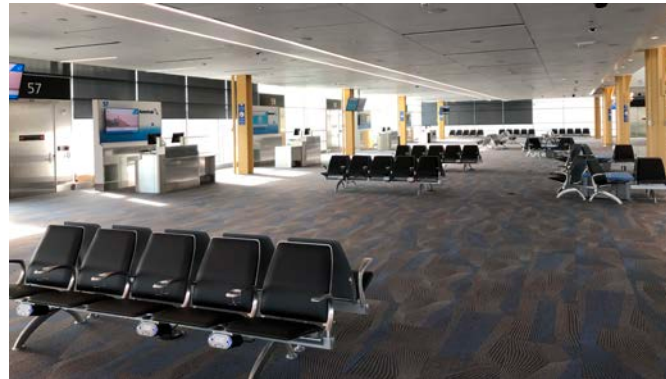


- Due to strong demand, the airline expects to fly more than 90% of its domestic seat capacity compared to summer 2019 and 80% of its international seat capacity compared to 2019
- American will operate more than 150 new routes this summer

New Regional Terminal at DCA

New 14-gate concourse transforms the travel experience, offering customers a more seamless journey



- Transitioned regional flight operations from Gate 35X to new 14-gate concourse at Reagan National Airport (DCA).
- Offering spacious gate areas, climate-controlled jet bridges and 850 new seats with panoramic views of the Washington, DC skyline
- New amenities, including four public restrooms, two mother's care rooms and an indoor pet relief area
- First 5 concessions coming in July, with more than 10 shopping and dining options and a 14,000 square-foot Admirals Club open by 2022
- Up to 85 daily departures scheduled from Gates 46-59 in the new concourse this summer.
